The currency you can use in Vaires-sur-Marne is the euro (€).




VENUE

- Water flow during a descent is 7 to 13 m³ / s depending on the activity
- 40 meters boat lift system
- 1100 meters initiation basin, and the surface of the landscaped river about 2000 m²

OUTLINE PROVISIONAL SCHEDULE

Canoe Freestyle safety rules for equipment :

All boats must be equipped at each end with anchor points for lifting, carrying or rescuing. An average hand must be able to grab easily these points.

Each competitor must wear a fastened safety helmet suitably fitted to his head. Only branded products designed for white water use will be accepted.

Each competitor must wear a buoyancy jacket. Only branded products with a recognised safety certification designed for white water use will be accepted.

Competitors must be able to free themselves from their boat at all times, quickly and easily.

- Each athlete competing must be entered by name.
- Team personnel must also be submitted for accreditation at this time. These entries will be used to produce the accreditation cards for all teams.

VISA REQUIREMENT

FIRST AID

Emergency medical services will be located in spectator's area near finish. This medical services will cover only emergency cases and all participants are responsible to arrange, at their cost, their own medical insurance policy.

Reminder ICF and ECA rules :

1.3.3 - Each National Federation must ensure that their athletes are in a good state of health and fitness which allows them to compete at a level commensurate with the level of the particular ICF competition.

1.3.4 - Each National Federation must ensure that their athletes, team officials, as well as the National Federation itself, carry appropriate health, accident and personal belongings insurance.

COVID-19 HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOL

Each Participating National Federation will be expected to have undertaken their own risk assessment and have a Covid-19 safety protocol in place and will require to have taken the precautionary measures prior to travel.

Each Participating National Federation is responsible for all costs (including medication) should any member of their Team be required to go into quarantine at any time from arrival to departure and/or be hospitalised or to return to the country of departure. The National Federation oblige all nations to provide EU DIGITAL COVID CERTIFICATE (Health Pass) or a negative PCR test (less than 72 hours) before participating in the competition.

The Host National Federation or the Host Organising Committee does not accept any responsibility for Covid-19 infection that occurs during or after the competition but will take all advised precautionary measures to reduce the risk of transmission.

Facemask will have to be worn at the competition venue at all times.

Disinfection stations will be located throughout the venue.
