Team Leaders Meeting

This mandatory session will occur at the Powerhouse on Saturday, October 7th. The session will begin at 09:00am. The address is 1205 Front Avenue Columbus, GA 31901. Each National Federation is required to have 1 (one) Team Leader present and if that leader is not fluent in speaking English than you are allowed to bring a second representative to the meeting.

Future of Freestyle Forum

Open to all athletes, coaches, and affiliates. This is a moderated opportunity to give feedback in small group format to the ICF Committee regarding the goals and ambitions of freestyle paddling.

ICF Development Camp

The ICF, HOC and Whitewater Express are delighted to announce the details of our development camp. This year's camp will be aimed at emerging nations. So far, Uganda, Chile, and China have all signed up for the camp, with more countries. to be confirmed.

The camp will run from the 4th to the 14th of October, with a mix of land and water sessions. We are also delighted to announce our camp coaches, Maxi Montoya and Valerie Bertrand, with other coaches to be confirmed.

Judges Seminar

The ICF judge's seminar will happen from 2nd to 4th of October at the Powerhouse. The first 2.5 days will be dedicated to learning and training, last half day will be used for exams. 10 to 12 trainees will attend, they are judges in their country or at international events.

Fees to apply to the seminar are set at 50€, accommodations are handled by applicants themselves.

Judges Fee

As the ICF regulations require there will a fee towards the judges of the competition to cover some expenses. The fee is \$55 Euros.

ICF will invoice each National Federation for the Judge's fee and then the National Federation will choose to invoice the athletes at their own discretion.

Nominal entries

Nominal entries close: September 29, 2023

Each athlete competing must be entered by name.

Team personnel must also be submitted for accreditation at this time. These entries will be used to produce the accreditation cards for all teams.

Reminder

Entries or accreditation requests sent directly to the committee, or the competition organizer will NOT be accepted.

The Athlete must use the code before making the reservation, otherwise they will not have access to the drop off on Bay Ave. The one-way rate without the code is currently \$57.00. Please book your trip with or without the code working so you can be sure to arrive in Columbus in a timely manner.

Anti-Doping Education

In line with ICF rules for ICF World Championships, ICF World Cups and ICF Ranking Races and Continental Championships, every athlete, coach and support personnel must pass the relevant anti-doping online course on the Anti-doping Education Learning Platform (ADEL) corresponding to their role: [ICF \(ADEL\) online anti-doping course](#). If someone has already completed the course, they do not have to re-take it. If you are unsure whether you have completed the course, please contact your National Federation.

Opening Ceremony

The Opening Ceremony will take place on Saturday, October 7th at 6:30 (18:30) at The Phenix City Amphitheater (508 Dillingham Street Phenix City, AL 36867). Teams are asked to assemble and be ready at 7:00 (19:00) to parade. Teams are asked to:

- Arrive in National Federation tracksuits and accreditation between 6:00 – 6:30 pm, ready to parade at 19:00.
- Assemble at 508 Dillingham Street Phenix City, AL 36867 (walking distance from campground)
- Nominate one female and one male per team for carry flag and country signage (both provided by HOC)
- Have entire team and leaders join the parade, plan to stay behind the flag throughout the parade
